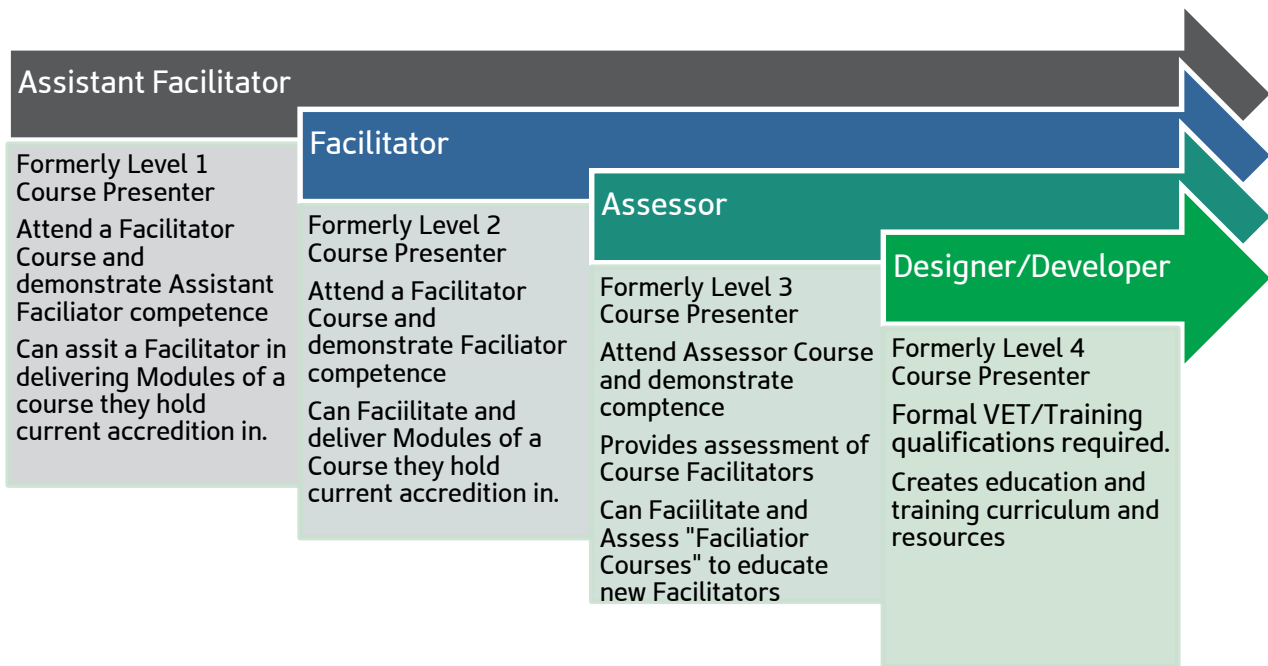


## Facilitator Course
