Demonstrates a sound <b>knowledge of attack strategy</b> , and positions accordingly in general play		*
Keeps "eyes on the ball" and anticipates the play to be in the next desired position		*

Checks both sides for <b>shooter(s)</b> , manages and communicates appropriately		
Has a <b>physical presence in the 5m line</b>		*

Game Management		
<b>Manages the "Toucher"</b> to an on-side position well and at the appropriate time		
Consistently manages/ <b>controls the Rollball</b> (no interference)		*
Manages the <b>defensive players (off-side players) in drives</b> , is aware of player prioritisation		
<b>Plays advantage</b> through pro-active/early communication to keep game flowing		*
<b>Manages physical play</b> and takes appropriate action as and when necessary		*
Identifies and <b>manages verbal conflict</b> appropriately and with confidence		
<b>Clear, concise signals</b> , whistle and explanations given with and for decisions so off-field referees can react quickly and set up the defensive line		*
Is not over officious or over referee the game with <b>pedantic rulings</b>		
Establishes <b>clear and audible communication</b> with players		*
Displays a detailed <b>understanding of the rules</b> and their application to the game		*
Team Work and Communication		
Consistently <b>sets a 5m line reference point from off field position</b>		*
Provides good <b>support to on-field referee</b>		
Builds a good <b>rapport</b> with wingers and links to enhance teamwork		*
<b>Communicates with realigning players</b> (defenders) to assist on-field referee with 5m control.		*
<b>Is supportive and in sync with referee team</b> decisions, demonstrates appropriate leadership		*
Adopts very <b>good off field positions</b> to assist with decision making		*
Referee Systems		
<b>Interchanges made with confidence</b> , shares the game workload, initiates the interchanges		*
<b>Communicates effectively on field entry</b> , uses options to eliminate penalties on entry		*
Demonstrates <b>good field entry positioning</b> , uses short side if appropriate, establishes the 5m line early/quickly		*
Aware of <b>player rotation from the sub box</b> and reacts accordingly to eliminate game chase		
<b>Exits field at an angle</b> to ensure the oncoming referee can take early control		
On <b>exit maintains game awareness</b> to ensure management of any incident/assist on-field referee		*
Scoreline		
<b>Is close to Touchdown</b> situations and has a clear view of the ball and touches at and behind the Scoreline, is aware of set plays and is well positioned for all scoring opportunities		*
Demonstrates a good <b>knowledge of attack strategy</b> and positions accordingly on Scoreline		
<b>Anticipates the long ball</b> , moves accordingly to maintain sight and good proximity to the ball		*
Effectively <b>manages defenders within 5m of the Scoreline (standoff)</b>		
<b>Communicates effectively with on field referee</b> to keep players moving forward, <b>off the Scoreline</b>
