Subject: Variation – Touch Football Australia Anti-Doping Policy 2015

Variation to the Touch Football Australia Anti-Doping Policy 2015

Minor variation to the Anti-Doping Policy, 2015 of Touch Football Australia to recognise the replacement of the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority by Sport Integrity Australia from 1 July 2020.

From 1 July 2020 the Anti-Doping Policy, 2015 is varied as follows:

- » Any and all references to the:
 - Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) are to be read as references to Sport Integrity Australia;
 - *Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority Act 2006 (Cth) (ASADA Act)* are to be read as references to the *Sport Integrity Australia Act 2020 (Cth)*; and
 - *Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority Regulations 2006 (Cth) (ASADA Regulations)* are to be read as references to the *Sport Integrity Australia Regulations 2020 (Cth)*.
