ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. Agenda

In accordance with clause 17.3 of the TFA Constitution, a further notice for the Annual General Meeting will be provided to those members listed above at least 21 days prior to the Annual General Meeting.

Such notice shall include the specific location for the Annual General Meeting as well as all relevant information set out at clause 17.3 (c) of the TFA Constitution (which for the avoidance of any doubt will include an agenda setting out the general nature of business at the meeting).

2. Call for Motions

In accordance with clause 17.3 (b) of the TFA Constitution, Voting Members (as that term is defined under the TFA Constitution) are requested to submit notices of motion no less than 28 days prior to the AGM (by no later than 5pm Saturday 17 October 2020).

In accordance with clause 9 of the TFA Constitution, a Member or the Board may nominate a person for Life Membership which must be submitted on the prescribed form (Life Member Form attached).

Accepted nominations for Life Membership must be put to the Membership as a Special Resolution at the Annual General Meeting. Accordingly, nominations for Life Membership are requested to be submitted no less than 28 days prior to the AGM (by no later than 5pm Saturday 17 October 2020).

3. Election of Directors

In accordance with clause 20.4 of the TFA Constitution, the Voting Members are requested to provide nominations for three (3) Elected Director positions. Nominations must be received no less than 28 days prior to the AGM (by no later than 5pm Saturday 17 October 2019). A Voting Member may nominate a person to fill a vacancy.

A nomination must:

- » Be in the form required by the Board (see attached Nomination Form); and
- » All nominations must be signed by a nominator and seconder. Both nominator and seconder must be authorised representatives of an Affiliate, NSWTA or QTF. For the avoidance of doubt where the nominator is NSWTA or QTF, the seconder may be an affiliate of either NSWTA or QTF; and





» Certified by the nominee expressing their willingness to accept the position for which they are nominated.

All nominations must be submitted in accordance with the instructions contained in the included TFA Director Nominations Form.

Two (2) Directors will be elected to hold office for a three-year term and in accordance with clause 20.5(b)(i) one (1) Director will be elected to hold office for the remaining year of a casual vacancy.

To facilitate an election for positions of different term lengths, the meeting will require Voting Members to elect Directors in two separate ballots. The first ballot will be for two (2) Directors who each will hold office for three years and the second ballot will be to elect one Director to serve for one year to fill the final year of the term of the Director position available due to a casual vacancy.

Consistent with clause 20.4(b) of the TFA Constitution, the Board has appointed a Nominations Committee to determine, in its sole discretion, the suitability of candidates seeking election to the Board. In accordance with clause 26 of the Constitution, the attached Nominations Committee Charter prescribes the authority delegated to the Nominations Committee.

In accordance with the Nominations Committee Charter at least one of the elected directors must be female to ensure gender balance on the Board.
