Design Brief

- » Submissions must capture the spirit of Touch Football while recognising and celebrating Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander culture in our sport.
- » Artist(s) to provide a brief background and story on the design. It would be expected that a storyline would accompany the artwork which clearly explains all aspects of the design.
- » Design must be authentic, and an original work of the artist submitting the design.
- » Design to be submitted as a landscape design.

*Artists must be 16 years or over

Process of selection

Representatives from TFA, TFA RAP Panel and Action Group will review all submissions and select the winning design based on relevance to the design brief.

The successful artist(s) will be confirmed no later than Friday September 9th, 2022.
