### Step 1 – Course Selection and Payment

Upon completing your profile details click on “Training Library” (Red Circle)

This will take you to the course landing page, select the Course Category for the Course you wish to enrol in (Blue Circles)

## Community Coaching General Principles

Touch Football Australia (TFA) is committed to providing best practice in Australia in Sport Education. As such TFA has in place a Sport Education Framework (Framework), a copy of this framework can be found [here](#).

Sport Australia has developed the Community Coaching General Principles (CCGP) online course to assist coaches in learning the basic skills of coaching, particularly those coaches working with children. The CCGP course is a prerequisite for the TFA Foundation Coach course as outlined in the Framework and takes 2-4 hours to complete.

The CCGP course is available free of charge to Australian Coaches, and can be accessed through the Sport Australia learning portal which can be accessed [here](#). If you don't already have an account, you will be required to create a login. Upon completion of the course you will receive access to your certificate.

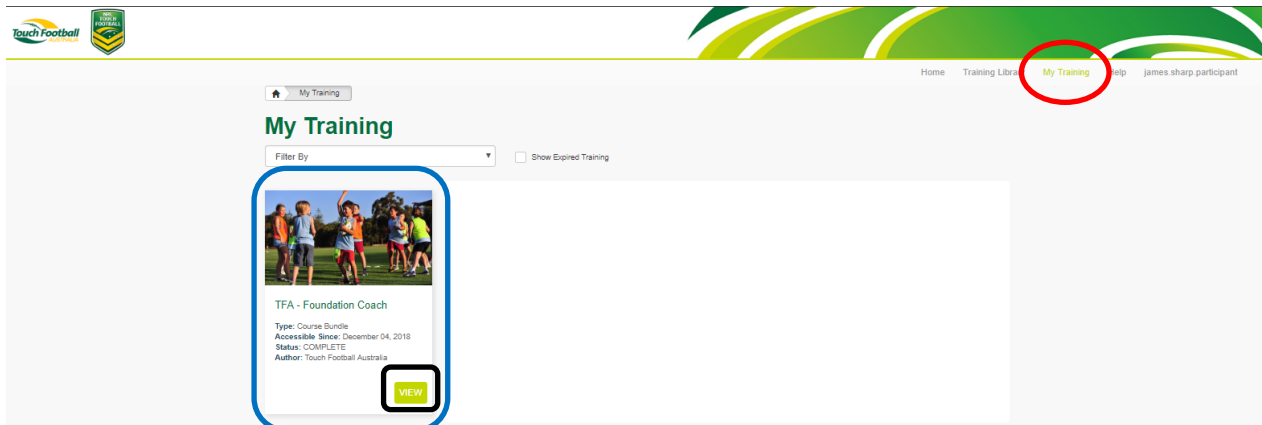


### Step 3 – Course work

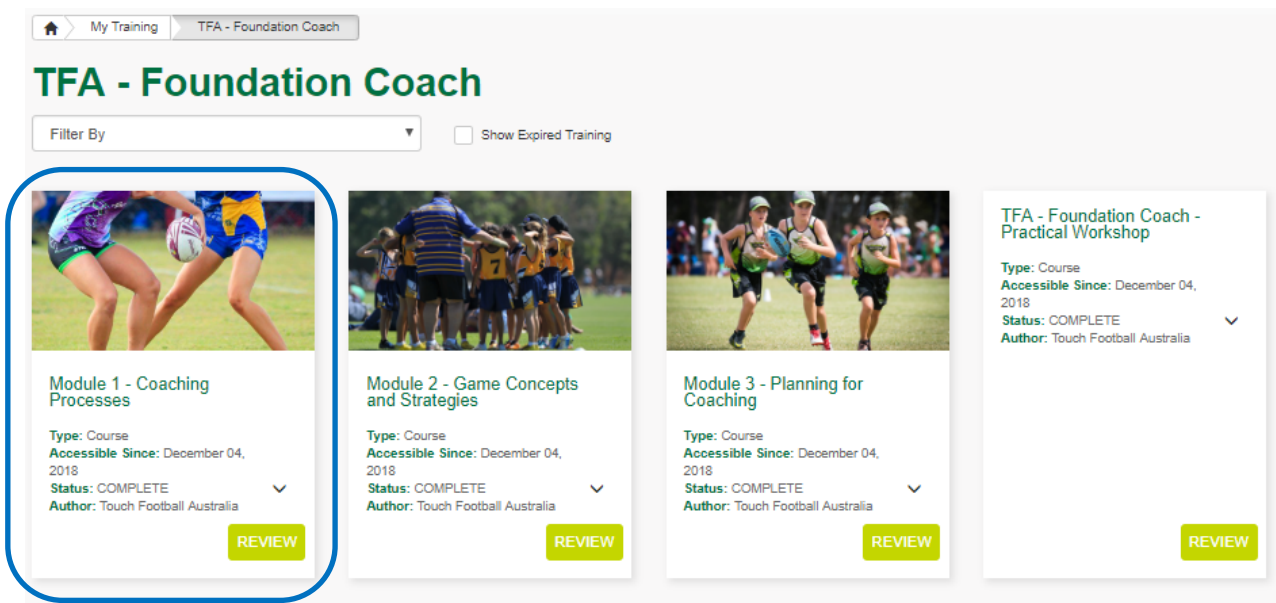
Once an assessor has reviewed your certificate upload you will then be able to access your Foundation Coach Course eLearning.
