

#### **MEDICAL**

Entities must have their own designated medical staff

TFA Event Medical are available for serious injuries:

- Flag down TFA Event Staff (identifiable by fluro yellow shirts) for injury assistance
- TFA Event Medical is on the ground floor of the northern stadium.
- · Sanitise hands on entry and exit

Please ensure entity medical staff are familiar with the updated TFA Concussion Policy (located at the bottom of the TFA website under the Policies tab)







#### **WEATHER**



#### **VENUE – TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT**

Carpooling is encouraged. Please do not park in the garden beds around the venue.

Please respect the disabled parking bays and be considerate of those who need these spots. A more detailed parking map has been included in your managers pack.

#### **VENUE - ACCESS**

No vehicle access inside the venue Pedestrian access to stadium via Main Southern and Southeastern gate Venue Access No smoking or alcohol Overnight security present Although it is recommended no valuable items are left on site No spectators within 5 meters of fields No animals allowed With the exception of service animals. Owners are required to carry documentation with them at all times





#### **VENUE - TRAINING FIELDS & WARM UP**

Pre-event training is NOT to occur at the stadium. For available training fields, please contact Lauren.

During the event avoid warming up / cooling down on playing surfaces

Warm up / cool down permitted around fields and/or spare fields





#### TFA DISCIPLINARY PROTOCOL

Teams CAN be penalised for the behaviour of officials and spectators.



The lodging of an Incident Report by a referee may lead to a suspension or a sanction including but not limited to a fine or suspension to the offending party. This will be determined in accordance with the TFA Events Conditions of Entry and the TFA Disciplinary Regulations.






#### **UNIFORMS**

TFA will not accept players or officials in incorrect uniform. We expect that all teams are in exactly the same uniform.

If a player loses a shirt or it is damaged, you need to complete a change of number request form at tournament control. This is required for talent identification and disciplinary issues.






#### **SCORESHEETS & DISPUTES**

It is the responsibility of each team to allocate an appropriate person (i.e. Coach or Manager) to sign the score sheet at the end of each game. When signing the scoresheet, the nominated person acknowledges and accepts that the information is correct on behalf of the team.

**If you do not agree** with the information on the score sheet, **do not sign the score sheet** and lodge a protest via the Tour Leader within 60 minutes of the conclusion of the game.

If both teams do not agree or in the event of inconclusive evidence the score will be recorded as the score that the referees have recorded. If the score sheet has not been signed and the time has passed for a protest to be lodged, the information on the score sheet will be recorded.





#### **EXCESS PLAYERS**

Teams can register up to 16 players, however, only 14 players can participate in a game. If your team has more than 14 players, you must cross out any individual that is not participating in that particular match. Penalties apply for teams that have more than 14 players participate.

For finals eligibility, a minimum of one (1) round game must be played by each registered player.

Cross out players not participating in any match (14 maximum)

Please be accurate to avoid potential issues





#### **INTERCHANGE AREAS**

#### Number

- ·Maximum of 22 participants including coaches, managers, stand down players and medical staff per game.
- ·Dress code applies.

#### Interchanges

·To occur within Interchange Area boundaries.

#### Policing

- ·Please stay within Interchange Area.
- ·Enclosed footwear.

Interchange Area 20 Metres x 4 Metres (1 Metre off Sideline)


#### **Permitted Coaching Positions**

- » Interchange Area (remain within Interchange Area boundaries)
- » 5m behind dead ball line (where permitted, verbal or physical commands prohibited)



#### DROP OFF RULE - 8<sup>TH</sup> EDITION

If it is a draw at the end of regulation time in the final series, a drop-off will occur.
