WHAT IS ALL-ABILITIES?

Touch Football Australia's **All-Abilities** programs are completely inclusive, offering opportunities for individuals with intellectual and/or physical impairments to learn touch football skills and play the sport with their family members, carers, friends and even elite footy players.

The programs encourage participants to become active members of the sports community through inclusion. Our approach is structured in three progressive phases: First Step, Next Step and Game Ready programs. Each phase is designed to nurture key skills over a six-week period, providing a clear path for athletes and coaches to develop their skills.







WHAT IS TOUCH BEYOND LIMITS?

Touch Football Australia has been delivering this inclusive program, formerly known as Touch Football Specialised (TFS), which transitioned to All-Abilities in 2019. The Sport Australia Participation Grant streams supported this transition through grant funding in 2019 and 2021. In 2024, the program relaunches across all platforms to align the delivery and updated content in one central location with the name 'Touch Beyond Limits' encompassing everything that the program portrays.

The participation in All-Abilities programs and in state and national events is growing each year. As we step into this new phase with a renewed look, we're looking forward to creating even more opportunities for people of all abilities to experience the joy of touch football.

What's New?

- » An easily accessible 'Touch Footy' app now simplifies program management, ensuring smooth sessions for all.
- » The new launch of the program includes the 'Game Ready' extension of the All-Abilities program that is included with our First Step and Next Step module suite within the 'Touch Footy' app. This will provide opportunities for participants to visually understand the activity to gain faster skill-based acceptance and overall competencies.
- » Additional new branding alongside marketing templates for affiliates, empowering them to promote the programs.







In 'Flying Saucer' an athlete attempts to avoid the cone being thrown at them but must remain in the set area.




Clear Instructions

AFFILIATE REQUIREMENTS

Every Touch Football All-Abilities program run throughout Australia must adhere to these requirements:

- » Any person who runs an All-Abilities program must be accredited by completing the Foundation Coaching course and All-Abilities Inclusive Coaching Course through The Nest.
- » Each program must be registered with Touch Football Australia through MySideline. Touch Football Australia's inclusion team will provide affiliates with a registration link once all details of the program have been outlined.
- » All participants must register through the supplied MySideline link.
- » As the old logo is retired, the new logo must be used.
- » All programs must be run according to program guides and adhere to suggested modifications on the 'Touch Footy' app.
