Team Delegate

It is the responsibility of the team delegate to ensure that the team is adhering to the Darwin Touch Associations Conditions of Entry.

Key Responsibilities

- Nominate your team
- Send the link to players to nominate
- All teams must have a minimum of 6 players registered prior to the commencement of the season, by round 3 all teams must have a minimum 10 players registered.
- Only allow registered players to play
- Have all players in the same uniform
- Be responsible for your team, all players must abide by the local, Territory and National policies
- Assist the Association
 - If you need to forfeit notify us by midday on the day of play
 - Report all facility concerns to the Ground Manager ASAP
 - Provide a referee each week
