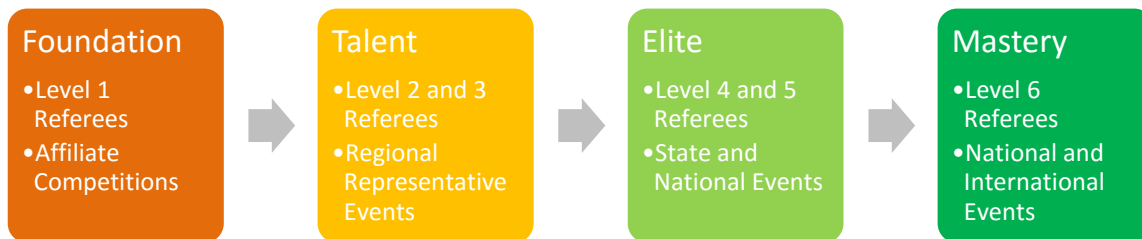


Foundation Referee Coach Course
